

Best Practices for Downstream Minerals Companies

Label your suppliers

Transparent supply chains start with clear labeling. Especially with complex supply chains, it is important to keep track of supplier data through an up-to-date database. Clearly establish the name of your supplier, the entity, location contact person, type of raw materials, and quantity orders.

Know your "risk" suppliers

Conduct a supplier risk analysis through a structured database to determine which suppliers are relevant to monitor for conflict minerals. Keep in mind that 3TG minerals can be "hidden" in other materials.

Assess your suppliers

Establish proper boundaries

Request audits, such as the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP) from the RMI, or lay down expectations and obligations in your supplier code of conduct.

Create remediation procedures

Set in place mechanisms through which cope with supplier nonconformity and formalise them into standard procedures.

Formalise everything into a policy

Develop a formalised policy through which address goals and commitments, and assign roles and responsibilities. This will guide your organisation through the complexity of due diligence.

Create a due diligence report

The necessity of creating a due diligence report depends on where you are located in the supply chain and the volume of 3TG which can be found in your products. As a direct importer, you are obligated to report annually on supply chain due diligence.

Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas

EU importers of tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold will have to carry out checks on their supply chain by following a five-step framework:

- Establish strong company management systems;
- 2) Identify and assess risk in the supply chain;
- 3 Design and implement a strategy to respond to identified risks;
- 4 Carry out an independent third-party audit of supply chain due diligence;
- 5) Report annually on supply chain due diligence.
